Darryl Warren from Pennsylvania has been involved with training and showing dogs in competitions since 1985. He started his 5-year-old champion and obedience titled cocker spaniel in agility. He has handled cockers spaniels, golden retrievers, and a lab in USDAA, NADAC, and AKC trials and more recently added a new venue DOCNA to the events in which he competes. He began teaching agility early in the 90's and was the training director of Keystone Agility Club until moving to Wind Gap, Pa. in 1995. His current dog, *Dixie*, a golden retriever was the 16th golden to earned her Agility Dog Championship in USDAA! In agility she has also earned her NADAC NATCH, her AKC MACH and MXF and the Silver Merit of Excellence in DOCNA. Dixie and Darryl have performed several Demonstrations for the Purina Incredible Dogs, including the National Dog Show, and competed at the Eastern Regional of the Incredible Dog Challenge in 2005, earning a Bronze medal. He came in second in agility at the All-stars Performance Event in 2003, is a member of the Coca Cola Classic K9's where he performs demonstrations at state fairs and pet expos across the country and has been on national TV several times including a live performance on the Today Show in New York City. From I-90: Take the Division Street exit and head north through Spokane on Division/Hwy 395. Continue north on Hwy 395 to Deer Park. After you reach Deer Park, turn left (west) on Monroe at the third exit (Monroe/Crawford, midway between MM 180 &181). Go approximately 1 mile to Antler Road. Turn right (west) on Antler Rd. Continue on Antler Road 3.5 miles to the stop sign at Williams Valley Rd, then continue on straight for another $\frac{3}{4}$ mile. Arena is located on the left (south) side of the road at 4913 Bittrich-Antler Rd
