## DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY

**Lewiston Roundup Grounds is located on the very South East corner of Lewiston.**

**From The North, South & East:**

Entering Lewiston(highway 12 & 95) cross the Memorial Bridge(Clearwater River). Left hand lane to four way stop light, this is a major intersection. Continue up 21<sup>st</sup> St. 21<sup>st</sup> St becomes Thain Grade. Thain becomes 14<sup>th</sup> St. Slight turn to the left becomes Ripon Ave. Turn right on Barr St. Barr St. becomes Barr Rd. Barr Rd. becomes Tammany Crk. Rd. LRG is a short drive on your right just past the alternative school. It's marked with a LRG sign.**(from Memorial Bridge to LRG is 9 miles)**

**CUTOFF FOR THOSE COMING FROM THE BOISE AREA:** After Culdesac, ID. and before Lapwai, ID. is a road to your left called Webb Rd.(left turn lane) If you follow Webb Rd., it turns into Tammany Crk. Rd. Follow Tammany Crk. Rd. around until you reach the Roundup Grounds.

**From The West:**

Highway 12 through Clarkston on Bridge Street. Cross Blue Bridge, turn right onto Snake River Ave. At the light, continue straight and past the next bridge. DO NOT take the on ramp and cross the Snake River. Continue straight, past Hells Gate State Park**(from Hells Gate Park to the LRG is 7.5 miles)**. At the stop sign, turn right. The LRG is a short drive on your right just past the alternative school. It's marked with a LRG sign.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**\*\*\* Dogs must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Pending numbers are no longer accepted. \*\*\***

You can register your dog online at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) and receive a registration number immediately

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25 service fee will be assessed for bank returned checks.

The Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook. Thru submission of entry, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

**\*\*\*ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES(except during runs and in the warm up area) PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!\*\*\***

The trial committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.

**Refund Policy:** Dogs may be withdrawn from one or more classes and receive a full refund provided written notification is given to the trial secretary prior to the closing on March 15, 2009. After closing, refunds will only be granted for ineligible dogs, including bitches in heat, and or ill/injured dogs or handlers. In such cases, a refund of entry fees, less \$3.00 per run to cover secretary, recording and judges fees, will be returned provided the trial secretary is given written notification prior to the beginning of judging for the day.

**Obstacles: Dog Walk and A-Frame ARE MATTED.** The following obstacles "may" be used at this trial. Open Tunnel, Non-Winged Jumps, Winged Jumps, 22" Weave Poles and Hoops.

**Check In:** Friday check in will begin at 4:00PM. Saturday and Sunday check in will begin at 7:00. Contestants only need to check in once. Please bring NADAC registration numbers and height card if applicable. Judges briefing Friday 4:30PM, walk thru 4:45PM. Saturday and Sunday judges briefing 7:30AM, first walk thru 7:45AM.

**Measuring:** All dogs entered in the Proficient Category in Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16" are required to be measured (except Veteran or Junior Handler dogs jumping 16"). Dogs jumping 20" and 20+ are not required to be measured. Dogs in the Skilled Category or dogs with permanent height cards do not need to be measured. Measurement forms may be obtained at <http://nadac.com/Application-for-Permanent-Height-Card.htm>.

**Aggression Policy:** NADAC handles aggressive dog incidences and poor sportsmanlike conduct reports on an individual basis. When NADAC receives an incident report, the circumstances are evaluated and if deemed appropriate, witnesses will be contacted. Depending on the circumstances, NADAC will issue a warning letter, place the dog/person on probation, or suspend the dog/person from entering future trials.

**THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.**

**Veteran or Disabled Handlers:** Handlers aged 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. In the non-jumping classes this option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers only. The Veteran/Disabled handler division is to give additional time allowance to handlers, because of their age or mobility limitations. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled handler you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division.

## *“Electronic Timers Will Be Used”*

**IMPORTANT.** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the [NADACagility@yahoo.com](mailto:NADACagility@yahoo.com) list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the [www.NADACagility@yahoo.com](http://www.NADACagility@yahoo.com) list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

**Levels.** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

### AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. .
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), “WOOFF” (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), the Lewiston Roundup Grounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
- 1.6 Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial. I/We certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or to other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the “Agreement” printed above.
